

FAQ – Frequently Asked Questions

Q - Where do I include people who are only going to the Banquet?

A - A registration/meal/tour form should be filled out for each person even for those just going to the banquet.

Q - Where do I include our Spiritual Advisor?

A - A registration/meal/tour form should be filled out for the Spiritual Advisor.

Q - If it is not an election year does there need to be a Voting Delegate?

A - Yes, there always needs to be a Voting Delegate. There are motions to be voted on and sometimes resolutions as well. Each council should have ONE Voting Delegate.

Q - Who pays for the Voting Delegate?

A - Diocesan pays the **REGISTRATION FEE ONLY** for the Voting Delegate.

Q - What is an Accredited Delegate?

A - The Accredited Delegate votes in place of the Voting Delegate if for some reason the Voting Delegate is not available when the vote takes place. Each council should have ONE Accredited Delegate and may have up to two. The Accredited Delegate can vote for all motions on the floor except the election.

Q - Who Pays for the Accredited Delegate?

A - The council pays the registration fee for the Accredited Delegate.

Q - Is the council Spiritual Advisor / Priest supposed to buy wine for the council ladies attending the convention banquet?

A - NO. He may do so if he wishes, but it should not be expected.

Q - What does it mean when the convention is “**FRAGRANCE FREE**”?

A - Many people attending the convention have an allergy or sensitivity to scent. Please refrain from using perfume, scented lotions and creams in consideration of those with asthma, allergies and/or sensitivity to scent.

Q - What is the Parallel Program?

A - The Parallel Program is for all delegates not a part of the election process. It is hosted by the Life Members and is a learning tool. Those not voting are strongly encouraged to participate.
