I'm pleased to announce that Resolution 2019-01 LON Abortion and the Effects on Mental Health and Resolution 2019-02 LON Equal Access to Permanent Resident Status, an Amendment to the Express Entry System under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act as it relates to Religious Workers were both passed by unanimous vote as amended. The resolutions have now been passed on to Provincial Council for consideration at the 2019 Provincial Convention in Kingston this July.
