Special Directive re Development & Peace

It is with great joy that I am able to report to you that the ban on donating to Development & Peace has been lifted with exceptions.

Councils are free to donate to Development & Peace and support the Share Lent program. The condition is to request that your funds are directed to the 130-member agencies who support the values of our Catholic Faith.

There are still 52 agencies that are being scrutinized for adherence to our values.

This is great news, and I encourage each of you to promote our 1% collection, Share Lent support, and Development & Peace donations.

Please note: These donations must be sent directly to Development and Peace and are NOT to be sent through National Office as the CCCB has not released the hold on these funds. The next meeting of the CCCB is March 22, 2019 when this ban will be discussed.
