

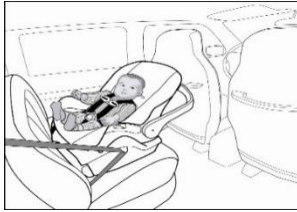

I'd like to draw your attention to a resolution to remove taxes from child safety products that are mandated by our government to protect babies and children

2017.03 Zero-Rated Status Under the Goods and Services Tax Provisions of 4 the Excise Tax Act for Child Safety Products

Whereas, the cost of child safety products listed in the Canada Consumer Product Safety Act is subject to the goods and services tax provisions of the Excise Tax Act; and

Whereas, the federal government has the authority to identify certain goods and services as being zero-rated for the goods and services tax; therefore, be it

Resolved, that national council of The Catholic Women's League of Canada in 97th annual national convention assembled urge the federal government to grant zero-rated status for regulated child safety products under the goods and services tax provisions of the Excise Tax Act.

Perhaps you might invite a doctor or a police officer to your meeting to further inform your members about the reasons for child safety products which parents must buy and still pay GST and HST on those products. We want to keep our children safe but taxes add an undesirable burden to the cost.
