Greetings to all my CWL sisters,

Originally, my directive was going to be about spicing up the spiritual component of your meeting but after attending the National Convention I decided to talk about a topic I wrote about when I was treasurer.

Father David Reilander from Catholic Missions in Canada was in attendance to receive a cheque for the money donated for the year. They have been in partnership with the Catholic Women's League for 25 years and have received donations totalling \$1,326,255.00 during that time. This is one quarter of the money that has been distributed to 23 Dioceses in Canada. This year Father David received a cheque for \$38,000.00. Considering the number of councils in Canada, this is really not very much! He told us that as you move north in Canada, living conditions become more like Third World countries and that Canadian missions are spiritually poorer than Africa. What does this mean for us? As treasurer I saw where your charitable donations went and Catholic Missions in Canada seemed to be on the lower end of the list. It would be wonderful if every council in our Diocese made a small donation to this worthwhile Canadian charity. Their website is www.cmic.info. Check it out!
